STRATEGIC PLAN & GOALS

Mission: NAPAN serves as the perianesthesia resource to advance specialty nursing within the community by the use of professional and educational opportunities.

Goal 1. NAPAN will dedicate itself to providing a resource for education and networking throughout our designated component area by:

- a. Offering 4-6 educational offerings
- b. Holding quarterly BOD meetings
- c. Maintaining website/newsletter
- d. Holding a State Conference
- e. Hosting an ASPAN seminar

Goal 2. NAPAN will promote APBANC/ASPAN award programs by:

- a. Honoring members for outstanding achievements, recruiter of the year and journalism awards
- b. Striving to receive ABPANC's Shining Star Award, Advocacy awards
- c. Submitting and obtaining Gold Leaf Award
- d. Promoting PANAW activities

Goal 3. NAPAN will welcome and mentor oncoming board members by:

- a. Actively recruiting board members
- b. Maintaining availability of willingness to serve forms
- c. Presidential contact to potential members via phone, letter or e-mail
- d. Holding a leadership retreat within 30 days of officer election
- e. Promoting the "up and comers" program at the component level

Goal 4. NAPAN will enhance membership opportunities and activities to increase membership outside of the Lincoln/Omaha metro areas by:

- a. Seeking contact personnel outside of metro area
- b. Tracking renewal status on an ongoing basis
- c. Contacting non-members attending NAPAN functions by e-mail, letter or phone
- d. Sending a retention letter for current members who are due to renew their membership
- e. Institute Skype so we can involve District Representatives and out state members

Goal 5. NAPAN will encourage evidence based practice by:

- a. Collaborating with members on one research project (minimal) per year
- b. Inviting research experts to lecture and mentor
- c. Surveying members regarding their research needs
- d. Work closely with NAPAN members who are conducting research

Goal 6. NAPAN will continue to welcome new members by:

- a. Communication via welcome packets continuing information about component newsletter, website, contact information and a discount coupon for educational offerings
- b. Continuing certification classes and mentoring by ABPANC/NAPAN coaches/champions in communities outside of Omaha/Lincoln as requested
- c. Recognizing certified members and offering discount fees to activities

Goal 7. NAPAN will continue to give members financial support through scholarship programs and funding for national Conference by:

- a. Funding scholarships for advance degrees, certifications and educational opportunities.
- b. Funding 1-2 members registration fees for National Conference
- c. Funding 2 board member's expenses for National Conference and other ASPAN related responsibilities
- d. Napan will host a Free Education Offering for all members to celebrate PANAW Week

Goal 8. NAPAN will continue to improve its website by:

- a. Maintaining the quarterly on-line newsletter, by-laws, information and announcements
- b. Continuing necessary operations of component owned website
- c. Including a schedule of component planned events for the ease of scheduling attendance

Goal 9. NAPAN will strive to increase member awareness of governmental issues through the website, newsletter, state legislature and contact with ASPAN's GA chairperson by:

- a. Funding NAPAN GA chair to visit legislative events
- b. Encouraging NAPAN GA chair to visit legislative website and report activities via newsletter and website
- c. Attending at least one day of state legislature
- d. Procuring a proclamation from the NE state governor for PANAW week

Goal 10. NAPAN will promote community involvement by:

- a. Participating in health fairs, nursing school functions and community organizations as available
- b. Collecting money at each of the educational programs to be donated to a local food bank
- c. Inviting nursing students to NAPAN functions free of charge
- d. Visit a nursing school making them aware of NAPAN and what it has to offer
- e. Supporting local military and veterans organizations to include the Omaha Veterans Hospital
- f. Group project this year is to help out the homeless vets by donating personal items, clothing, kitchen utensils, and bedding.
